Uniforms

Practice uniforms and travel attire are purchased by the player. Game uniforms and warm-ups will be checked out at the beginning of the season and must be returned at the conclusion of the season. Players are responsible for the cost of replacing unreturned or damaged items.

Travel

- Players should travel with the team on the bus for away games.
- If a player needs to ride home with a parent the parent must complete the travel form (see attached). A player who does not ride the bus home will only be permitted to travel with his parents. A player will not be allowed to ride home with another player's parents unless arrangements are made prior to game day.
- A bus will not be provided for in-town away games. (Poudre, Rocky Mountain, Fossil Ridge)
- Players will be granted early release from class when necessary.
- Bring snacks. The booster club will be organizing meals for away games. Thanks!

Attending Practice and Games

Parents are welcome to attend practice. If you elect to attend practice please remain a silent observer while practice is in session. Remember that practice is a time where players are working on new skills and developing an understanding of new concepts. We want the players to be comfortable and not feel extra pressure from additional outside coaching or criticism.

Please attend as many games as possible. Your son is committing a lot of time and energy. Please support him. While attending games, please represent Fort Collins High School in a positive manner.

Playing Time

Playing time will be determined by the coach. Playing time will not be distributed evenly. Performance in practice and games, attendance and attitude are the primary factors for determining playing time.

Conflict Resolution

If you or your son has a concern you/he wishes to discuss with the coach, please do so. A great first step is to counsel your son on how to have a productive discussion with his coach. If you feel that your son was unable reach a resolution of an issue or gain a better understanding of a situation by having a discussion with the coach, please contact the coach to discuss or make arrangements for a meeting.
